

Job Seeker Services at the PA CareerLink® South Central Region

PA CareerLink® Website: Enroll at www.pacareerlink.pa.gov to save your employment information, search for jobs, find workshops, and more!

Career Resource Center: Use a computer to enroll on www.pacareerlink.pa.gov, search and apply for jobs, write resumes and cover letters, and use career tools. You will also find job fair flyers, job-related handouts, and information on training providers. Get copies of your resume and send job-related faxes.

Training & Employment Services: Under the Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) you can find assistance with a variety of training and employment needs. Eligibility criteria may apply.

HSE/GED, Adult Basic Education & English as a Second Language Classes: Take classes to prepare for your High School Equivalency Test or brush up on basic skills through classes provided by the York County Literacy Council

Workshops: Review the latest schedule and register for a variety of job-related workshops after enrolling on our website www.pacareerlink.pa.gov.

Staff One-on-One Services: Training opportunities, labor market information, employment counseling, available on-site workshops, etc.

Training: On-the-Job or classroom training assistance may be available if you are unable to obtain suitable employment with your current skills.

Assessments: WIOA participants work with a career advisor and complete and assessment to help you find out where your interests and abilities combine for guidance on what career path to take.

Veterans Services: Veteran and eligible spouses receive priority of service. Veterans with significant barriers to employment also receive the support of a Disabled Veterans Outreach Program staff member.

Youth Services: Specialized programs are available for eligible in school & out of school youth ages 14-24.

Senior Community Service Employment

Program: SCSEP assists low-income, unemployed seniors (age 55+) to gain new skills and re-enter the workforce.

Office of Vocational Rehabilitation: Apply for services (including vocational evaluation, counseling and job placement assistance) with

OVR, which serves people with physical, mental and emotional disabilities that present a substantial

barrier to employment.

All services are offered to you at no cost.
